Details of the hybrid style

This symposium will be held in the following three parallel sessions.

- Room A @ 2F main conference hall of Building A
- Room B @ 3F meeting room of Building A
- Room C @ 2F conference room A of New Building A

Each conference room uses either "a microphone and speakers for a videoconferencing system installed at the venue" or "a portable microphone and speakers system for remote conferences". In both cases,

- Remote participants, presenters, and chairs participate in the Zoom meeting as in a regular online meeting.
- Onsite participants, presenters, and chairs use the onsite videoconference system for audio and "Zoom's screen sharing function" from their own computers for screen sharing.

Before the symposium, please do the following.

Even if you are attending on-site, please pre-register for Zoom (especially for presenters & chairs) and bring your own laptop on the day of the event.

1. Please register in advance from the registration link below.

When you have registered, you will receive an email with a link to join.

2. Webcam, speaker, microphone is required for remote participants. It is possible even if there is no webcam, but it is recommended to use it for smooth communication. Zoom can also be used with cameras, speakers, and microphones built-in PCs and smartphones, but since the built-in microphone is easy to pick up noise and environmental sounds and prone to howling, it is recommended to use a headset.
