This symposium will be held in a hybrid style using Zoom meetings. Please note that Zoom version 5.3.0 or later is required.

Details of the hybrid style

This symposium will be held in the following three parallel sessions.

- Room A @ 2F of Building A in front of the main conference hall: Hybrid Room
- Room B @ 2F of Building A: Hybrid Room
- Room C @ 2F of Building A, behind the main conference hall: Online Room

In the Hybrid Rooms, videoconferencing system with stable microphones and speakers are used. On the other hand, the Online Room uses a portable (small-group) microphone and speaker system for remote meetings. Except for the quality of the microphone and speaker system, there is no difference between the hybrid room and the online room from the audiences', presenters' and chairs' point of view. In both cases,

- <u>Remote participants, presenters, and chairs participate in the Zoom meeting as in a</u> regular online meeting.
- <u>Onsite participants, presenters, and chairs use the onsite videoconference system</u> for audio and "Zoom's screen sharing function" from their own computers for screen sharing.

Before the symposium, please do the following.

Even if you are attending on-site, please pre-register for Zoom (especially for presenters & chairs) and bring your own laptop on the day of the event.

2. Webcam, speaker, microphone is required for remote participants. It is possible even if there is no webcam, but it is recommended to use it for smooth communication. Zoom can also be used with cameras, speakers, and microphones built-in PCs and smartphones, but since the built-in microphone is easy to pick up noise and environmental sounds and prone

to howling, it is recommended to use a headset.

Please start your presentation as instructed by the chairperson.

5. To share the screen, click the "Screen Sharing" button in the center of the screen and select the screen or application you want to share. Click "Stop Sharing" to end screen sharing.

6. The presentation time is 30 minutes including 10 minutes for Q&A. Please manage the presentation time by yourself.
