Short Summary, Conclusions and Actions

**1. Hinode Program and Instrument Status**

**a. Instrument Status Review**

XRT is nominal (KR).

SOT is nominal (MD).

EIS is nominal (SM).

IRIS is nominal (MG).

**4. Any problems with the recent/upcoming HOPs? Have they all been run or are in the queue?**

HOP 507 – **AI (JD) confirm that proposers agreed to EIS suggestions.** HOP 508 – OK. HOP 509 – **AI (JD) follow up to make sure that proposers know to contact the teams for flare observations.**

Ongoing practice/trial for seven-day plan where Hinode focuses on major flare watch targets during DKIST observing window. MG mentioned 3 DKIST windows in the period 2<sup>nd</sup> half July to end August.

HOP 173 – update with new XRT and SOT requests. EIS not updated. Looks like planning schedule can accommodate this HOP in among the runs of open and new HOPs during the period of 2025/07/29-2025/08/03.

HOP 510 – SNIFS rocket launch is during focus mode therefore will run the SOT/EIS/XRT sequence of observations for scheduled launch date and a few more days in case the date slips. Pointing can be changed during the week by ISAS while not requiring 3 COs.
