4. Any problems with the recent/upcoming HOPs? Have they all been run or are in the queue? I/HOP 173, 507, 509, 511 – Now out of eclipse season so Hinode can respond to PROBA 3 pointing changes (I/HOP 507).

5. New HOPs

HOP 512 – Solar Orbiter North Pole observations SOT with PHI/HRT (similar to South pole campaign run in March/April). SOT can't do 21 days but interruptions are not an issue. Prioritize 14/15 October during EUI/HRI bursts. AI – EIS to recommend studies to be run every 2nd or 3rd day. HOP 513 – Solar Orbiter Prominence observation at west limb over 24 hrs. Prioritize 5 October 20:30-22:00 UT and 6 October 08:00-12:00 UT. AI – Discuss with proposers reasonable expectations for outside of priority periods. Look at whether there is an overlap with other SOOPs. HOP 514 – Solar Orbiter AR upflow region with DKIST in September. Repeat of previous SOOP/HOP. All teams are OK with HOP. Scheduled HOPs to be adjusted to accommodate scheduling in September. HOP 515 – Solar Orbiter major flare watch – similar to previous SOOP/HOP. All Hinode teams are OK with HOP and IRIS is discussing specifics.
