Short Summary, Conclusions and Actions

1. Hinode Program and Instrument Status

a. Instrument Status Review

XRT is nominal (KR).

SOT is nominal (MD).

EIS is nominal (SM).

IRIS is nominal (MG).

2. Review and discussion of Action Items from 225th SSC meeting. None.

3. Review and discussions of open I/HOPs

I/HOPs 81, 130, 409, 412, 485 – all in the calendar. HOP 507 uncertain but discussion for 2nd half of December (not in the calendar as of 15 Dec).

HOP 516 - EIS support for ground-based observations of total eclipse of 12 August 2026 proposed by Enrico Landi. Expecting more eclipse observations so will have to decide on allocations in the future.

Request from Jack Jenkins for Solar Orbiter 14 February 2026. Requested to put through the usual IHOP process. **KR to follow up with Jack.**
